Founded by Mrs. **Rosehine Nyakeriga** in 2014, **Zikar Child Fund** emerged from a deep personal journey. As a mother, Mrs. **Rosehine** faced incredible challenges facing funds for her son, who was born with a severe heart condition. Throughout his early years, she regularly took him for check-ups, but as he turned ten, his condition worsened, requiring urgent treatment that came with a staggering price tag of **Ksh.4.7 million**. In her quest to save her son, Mrs. **Rosehine Nyakeriga** reached out to friends and family for support, but her efforts only yielded **Ksh.37,000**. Undeterred, She embarked on grassroots fundrais-ing campaign, utilizing her father's pickup to conduct road shows, visiting local market-places, and appealing to the generosity of the public. She also engaged local churches in her mission, sharing her story and seeking assistance.

After much struggle, perseverance and the support of compassionate community, she suc-cessfully raised enough funds for her son's treatment. Today he is thriving and pursuing his university education as a second year student. Inspired by her experience, Mrs. **Rosehine** felt a calling to assist other families facing similar challenges. This passion led to the formal establishment of **Zikar Child Fund**, an organization which was officially registered in 2022.

Since its inception, the organization has made a significant impact in assisting 11 chil-dren in need critical medical treatment. 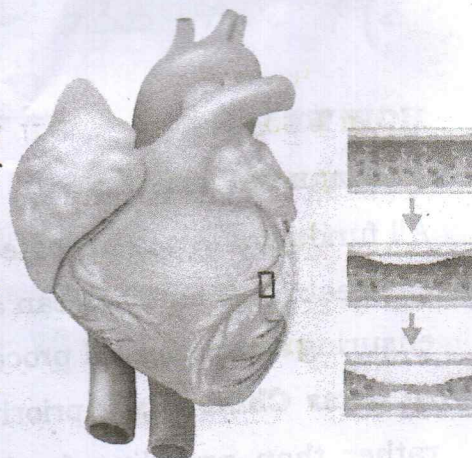
Our Vision

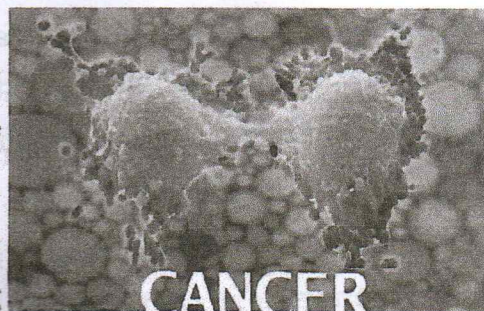
♦ Heart Diseases

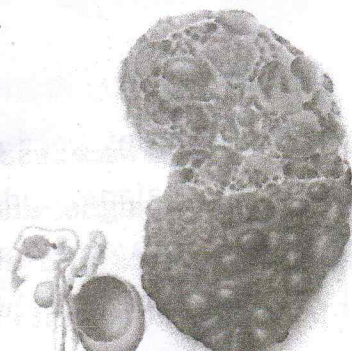
Cancer

THE CONSTITUTION OF ZIKAR CHILDS FUND

ARTICLE 1: THE NGO NAME & ADDRESS

ZIKAR CHILDS with a postal address of 3869-40200 Kisii C/O Entanda Primary School of Marani sub-county

ARTICLE 2 THE NGO OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the NGO shall be

To help children aged between 1 month -17 years with spinal cord problem, heart kidney access, and medical care in various hospital in the country and outside the country.

To raise funds for those children going to high school but lack school fees.

Providing basic amenities such as food and clothing to vulnerable children.

Community advocacy on health issues,

ARTICLE 3: THE NGO ACTIVITIES

The core activities for the group shall be

>Requesting/raising funds from the general public and geared to meet the above stated objective

Agribusiness

ARTICLE 4: THE NGO MEMBERSHIP

For one to be a member of the group, He/She

* Must be 18 years and above and with a national ID card

• Must be disciplined and of integrity

• Must register with a non-refundable fee of Ksh. 2000

At the moment (time of registration) the ^{Ngo} CBO is made up of 16 members comprising 7 men and 9 ladies.

ARTICLE 5: THE NGO ELECTIONS

The ^{Ngo} CBO shall be conducting its elections for new leaders after every 2 years. However, any unbecoming behaviour by the incumbent leaders calls for immediate impeachment. Besides voluntary resignation by a leader on whatever ground is allowed at any given time.

ARTICLE & THE NGODISCIPLINE

The following tenets/rules shall be followed to ensure the group discipline

Failing to attend group meetings without a valid reason will attract a fine of Ksh. 300 Late coming to meetings without a valid/sound reason attracts a fine of Ksh. 100 Noise making during group meetings attracts a fine of Ksh. 50

Revealing of the organization's secrets leads to a two sittings suspension. Repeating of the same leads to automatic expulsion.

Drunkenness during meetings calls for expulsion from the particular meeting and a fine of Ksh.500

☐ Expulsion can apply in extreme circumstances e.g. where a member gravely violates the organization's constitution

ARTICLE 7: TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP

It can arise under the following circumstances:

- Voluntary exit by a member Expulsion of the member

ARTICLE 8: ROLE OF THE GROUP OFFICIALS

Being the custodian the group's documents e.g. the group certificate, the minute book, the group membership cards etc.
